Neo Environmental were commissioned by Williams House Energy Ltd to conduct a geophysical survey as part of the archaeological investigations preceding the proposed solar farm.

Neo Environmental's involvement:

Neo Environmental provided a geophysical survey at the site in order to investigate potential buried archaeological remains.

Project Outcomes:

- The geophysical survey identified a number of potential anomalies indicative of buried archaeology, including numerous plough lines, possible enclosures, boundary plots and internal features. These features appear to extend out of the field boundaries to the west and east, continuing into the next field system.
- The results of the survey show the agricultural land management over time as well as indicating the potential for further sub-surface archaeology of possible interest.
